 - ii. Describe the timing of sequence of procedures that will be performed in each study, and how many procedures one animal may undergo.
 - iii. Describe how many studies one animal may undergo.

- e. [Husbandry](#)
 - i. Describe animal transportation, if applicable.
 - ii. Describe any non-standard housing requirements, non-standard husbandry or care, and non-standard experimental requirements.
 - iii. This is where many of the “exceptions to the regulations” are described.
 - f. [Animal Disposition](#)
 - i. Describe how animals will be euthanized.
 - g. [Attachments](#)
 - i. Attach supportive documents.
